Fabrice's Village



This young boy (blue shirt) on the right holding the hand pump is one among many Haitian boys and girls our Lord Jesus uses to replicate the miraculous scene of using five pieces of bread and two fish to feed over five thousand people. In our October 2017 newsletter, we shared the story of young Fabrice riding a donkey when available or walking miles up and down the mountains to bring water to his family. If you know the reality of Haiti, you can understand the burden of a child daily carrying five gallon jugs of water up and down a steep rocky mountain, very often under a burning sun. It's not something done occasionally, once in a while. It's a task done twice a day for most boys and girls living in remote areas of Haiti. This is the type of situation that at Water for Life our field coordinator and the drilling teams could never get used to, often saying, "Oh God, why is it like this?"

As we remember when the disciples told Jesus to release the people because they were very hungry, Jesus asked them who in the crowd has some food. Among the 5,000 adults, without counting the women and children, only one boy offered the little he had without even knowing what they were going to do with his little portion. Jesus lifted it up to the Father to bless it, fed all the crowd, and 12 baskets of left-overs were still available.

Little Fabrice was that boy the Lord was using to bless this community with the little he had. He offered his obedience and the little energy he had to take on the daily chore of providing water to his family. He daily sacrificed part of his schooling, his childhood, to help his parents. We know for sure the Lord is seeing the sacrifices of the children in Haiti. We know for sure He gives them the obedience and the strength to go day after day, year after year, carrying jugs and jugs of water for their families. We know for sure the Lord Jesus lifts daily all the loving sacrifices of all the Fabrices living in Haiti and other parts of the world. We know for

sure the Lord blesses their sacrifices and provides for the needs of thousands. Today the Lord has provided, through a donor, a well closer to Fabrice's village where the entire community can get closer access to clean water.



This is how the Lord is using the sacrifice of little Fabrice to bless his neighbors. This is what you donors, prayer partners, and Water for Life staff are about. We are the ones our Lord Jesus uses to pray for the needy people. We are the ones He uses little children's sacrifices to provide the loaf of bread and fish to feed the hundreds of thousands of thirsty people, and to water the dry land, providing food for the needy people of Haiti.

It is such a heavenly team Jesus is making with us! Little Fabrice from that remote village offering his obedience and sacrifices; you donors very far away with selfless interest in Haiti, except being moved by the love and compassion of Christ, you staff of Water for Life giving yourself not for the sake of a paycheck, but working as unto the Lord. It must be GOD.

Thank you Father for opening our spiritual eyes so we can see the majesty of the Love of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Thanks for choosing little Fabrice to teach us that no one and nothing is too small for you to accomplish your purpose. Thanks for all the donors, prayer partners and staff giving their prayers, money and time to demonstrate the unconditional love of Jesus Christ.
