We thank God for the completion of another school year! We are grateful to have dedicated teachers and staff to oversee the 350+ students and to direct them in their studies, having devotions with them in their classrooms daily, and being role models for them!



In May, students in 9th and 10th grades from the Help from Above school in Pasbwadòm along with their teachers visited the city of Cayes, which is the first tourist destination of Haiti.

They visited the wonderful Botanical Garden, where they could admire the beauty of nature, then proceeded on to one of the vetiver perfume oil factories in the area, where they had the chance to learn about vetiver plants whose roots are the basis for the biggest industry in the area.

The Water For Life team in Cayes was happy to receive this group of students who had the opportunity to meet and benefit from the words of wisdom from the Water for Life administrative staff and learned more about our water well drilling and mobile clinic program.

Water- A Vital Fveryday Necessity

"For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah." I Kings 17:16



More than half of people living in rural areas in Haiti fetch water in sub-human conditions. Without a well close by, these women must draw water from places such as shallow dug wells into which they lower their bucket, or a pit dug into a muddy little stream; in all likelihood these sources are contaminated. Sadly, they have to fill their containers with this dirty water for their daily needs, knowing that in that bucket they carry bacteria that very possibly will make their children sick. These women continue to care for their families with the limited resources available. Courageously they will be carrying the heavy bucket on their head on the long way back home hoping for a miracle to soothe their souls.

As in the time of Elijah when God provided an inexhaustible source of oil and flour to the widow of Zarephath, we also believe that through the hearts of willing people the misery of these women will end as clean water will keep flowing out from wells.

Once these wells are drilled, the children in the village will no longer be threatened by waterborne diseases, the mothers won't be busy all day traveling long distance for water, and they will have more time for money income activities to meet the basic daily needs.

Whom shall the Lord call to bring them relief and comfort, meeting their physical needs through the gift of clean water that manifests the love of Jesus-Christ and the reality and power of God?

Our Father is calling us to share our blessings with his people. Providing them with a well means a life changing experience for many families. Your donation is a great contribution fulfilling the love of our Lord Jesus for us to be a blessing to one another. ~ The Water for fife Jean
