#### *When did your story with Water For Life begin?*

My journey with Water For Life began in August 2025 during a mobile clinic in Dory, Maniche, where I volunteered as a nurse taking patients' vital signs. In just two days, I was deeply moved by the team's compassion—toward the community and toward one another—and impressed by the wide range of services offered. This experience inspired me to join a mission I found truly meaningful. After applying for an internship, I was accepted in September for three months, and by the end of November I was hired as an administrative and logistics officer and nurse responsible for the pharmacy. Since then, I've been involved in data collection, pharmacy management, and organizing mobile clinics. This is how my story with Water For Life began, and I look forward to many more meaningful experiences ahead.

*How do you understand and appreciate the mission of Water For Life?*

From my perspective, the mission of Water For Life is rooted in love and mutual support. It promotes kindness, generosity, and solidarity, emphasizing the importance of contributing to the well-being of others. For people living in vulnerable conditions with limited access to basic needs, this mission is a powerful way of showing that they are not forgotten—that there are people who genuinely care about their situation. By offering care with compassion and dignity, Water For Life carries out a noble and deeply humanitarian mission that significantly improves the health of under-served communities.



***How do you understand your participation in this mission?***

Participating in this mission means helping others and contributing to their well-being. More specifically, it means offering comfort, love, support, and essential care to those in need. It is a mission that I can't accomplish alone but becomes possible thanks to this opportunity that Water For Life gave me to serve.

***What impact has this mission had on your life?***

This mission has allowed me to feel truly useful in a concrete way and has exposed me even more to the reality of hardship many people face, something we often overlook, whether out of helplessness or self-centeredness. Unfortunately, this reality continues to grow in our country. I also felt a deep sense of satisfaction knowing that I was contributing to something meaningful. Working with the team is a wonderful experience because of the respect and consideration they show both to one another and to the communities they serve. Participating in this mission has helped me grow as a person and strengthened my sense of humanity.
